

All-In Probabilities on the Flop

The following Table lists the probabilities of typical All-In Situations of two players on the flop. Experienced Poker Players know these values off by heart. Beginners should print the list and use it while playing Online Poker. The values are approximation, but are fine to calculate the Odds during a game of poker.

Name	Flop	Hand1	Hand2	Win1	Win2
Low Flush draw against Top Pair				38 %	62 %
Flush Draw with Over-card against Top Pair				50 %	50 %
Flush Draw against a Set (Drilling)				25 %	75 %
OESD (low) against Top Pair				35 %	65 %
OESD and Flush Draw (low) against Top Pair				55 %	45 %
ISD against Top Pair				20 %	80 %
TPTK against Top Pair worse Kicker				87 %	13 %
TPTK against Two Pair (Top 2 Pair)				16 %	84 %
TPTK against Two Pair (Top + 3rd Pair)				28 %	72 %
TPTK against Two Pair (2nd + 3rd Pair)				25 %	75 %
Top Pair against two higher Cards				75 %	25 %

Remarks:

- TPTK = Top Pair Top Kicker (Highest Pair and highest possible Kicker)
- OESD = Open Ended Straight Draw (2 Possibilities to hit the Straight)
- ISD = Inside Straight Draw (1 possibility to hit a straight)

Rule-of-thumb

If u hit top pair against a flopped set, your're toast!
